WHEREAS, the Butler Chain of Lakes (Down, Bessie, Butler, Blanche, Louise, Palmer, Chase, Tibet Butler, Sheen, Pocket and Fish) are a unique natural resource with excellent water quality, and

WHEREAS, THE Butler Chain of Lakes are of an exceptional recreational significance as demonstrated by their wide variety of support for outdoor activities, the intensity of their use and the outstanding quality of the areas involved, and

WHEREAS, the Butler Chain of Lakes have demonstrated their ecological significance by the ambient water quality, and

WHEREAS, the community interest in the Butler Chain of Lakes has been demonstrated over the years by the Chase family donation of Bird Island to the Audobon Society, by the legislative action creating the Windermere Water and Navigation Control District in 1963, and by the Community formation of the Butler Chain Conservation Association in 1969, and

WHEREAS, the Butler Chain of Lakes require the Antidegradation Protection which the State of Florida can provide.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WINDERMERE request the State of Florida designate the Butler Chain of Lakes as "Outstanding Florida Waters."
